- 2. Is it right for Hong Kong Government to consult the people of Hong Kong on GST?
- 3. Is GST a fairer tax than salaries tax?
- 4. Is it fair to the current salaries tax payers to bear the majority of the revenue responsibility of Hong Kong?
- 5. Should GST be implemented in Hong Kong?

Students from the eight universities of Hong Kong should be asked to debate on the above issues and monetary award of HK\$100,000 in the form of scholarship should be given each member of the winning team. Then Arthur Li will not refrain from joining the GST debate.
